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**INVITATION FOR BIDS**

1. The Government of Pakistan has received a credit from the *International Development Association* towards the cost of *Tax Administration Reform Project* and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this *credit* to payments under the contract for **Procurement of Furniture for Regional Tax Office at Islamabad.**
2. The **Federal Board of Revenue** invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for **Procurement of Furniture for Regional Tax Office at Islamabad.**
3. Bids shall be for the complete quantities given in the Bill of Quantities. Bids for partial quantities shall be rejected as non-responsive.
4. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from the Federal Board of Revenue and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 0900 to 1500 hours.
5. A complete set of bidding documents in *English* may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application at the address below and upon payment of a non refundable fee *equivalent to Pak Rs. 1000/-*. The method of payment will be direct deposit under Federal Government of Pakistan **Head of Account C-03870-Non Tax receipts-others on Challan 32-A** either in the **State Bank** or **National Bank of Pakistan**. Interested Bidder who wishes to receive the Bidding Documents through courier should provide an additional amount of **Rs. 300/-** for delivery within Pakistan.
6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **11:00 hours on 17<sup>th</sup> Septemeber, 2011** (Saturday). *Late bids* will be rejected, bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders or bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below at **1130 hours on 17<sup>th</sup> Septemeber, 2011**(Saturday).

7. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of an amount equal to *two (02) percent of the bid price valid for 148 days* from the date of opening of bid in the shape of *Bank Guaranty/ CDR/ Pay Order/Demand Draft*.
8. Price quoted shall be Delivered Duty Paid (DDP) including all applicable taxes/duties.
9. Bids shall be valid for period of (120) days after Bid opening.
10. All Government Taxes shall be deducted as per law. Proof of registration with Income Tax Department and Sales Tax Department should be enclosed with the Bid.
11. Bidders are requested to give their best and final prices as no negotiations are allowed/possible.
12. A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on *8<sup>th</sup> September, 2011 (Thursday) at FBR House to brief the prospective bidders on properly filling the Bidding Document or any clarification thereof.*
13. Bidders engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices (including collusion/polling) will be declared ineligible either indefinitely or for stated period of time for award of contracts finance by "**The World Bank**".
