CUSTOMS GENERAL ORDER NO. 19/2000

Subject: **PROCEDURE FOR TEMPORARY IMPORTATION AND SUBSEQUENT EXPORTATION OF DEFENCE EXHIBITION GOODS FOR IDEAS 2000 AT EXPO CENTRE (KEC) KARACHI.
TO BE HELD FROM 14.11.2000 TILL 17.11.2000.**

In pursuance of Joint Staff Head Quarters Case No: JS/O/Ops/2223 dated 20th January, 2000 on the subject cited above regarding forth-coming Defense Exhibition in the name of IDEAS 2000 to be held from 14-11-2000 to 17-11-2000, following procedure is prescribed in order to facilitate the clearance of goods to be imported by foreign exhibitors:-

1. The Karachi Expo Centre (KEC) University Road, Karachi, the site for exhibition, is declared as Customs Bonded Area, defined under section 12 of the Customs Act, 1969. The Customs Bonded Area will be supervised by Assistant Collector of Customs Bonds Section (Appraisement), Karachi.
2. The Coordination Cell IDEAS 2000 Exhibition and Export Promotion Directorate joint Staff Headquarters (JSHQ) shall provide Authorization Certificate in respect of each consignment imported for display in the above referred Exhibition.
3. Bills of Entry for Bond bearing the title "GOODS FOR IDEAS 2000" with complete description, quantity, value, classification and leviable rates of duty and taxes, along with JSHQ's Authorization Certificate, invoice and packing of goods shall be filed.
4. The Exhibitors shall be allowed to bring the consignments in their own name and the requirements for Imp Regn, S.Tax Regn, NTN Regn. etc will not be applicable.
5. The Appraising Group of the respective Collectorate shall make assessment on the basis of declaration and above-referred documents under 2nd appraisement system. The bill of entry shall be handed over to Customs Agent for onward submission to the Customs Staff posted at Wharves/ Airport.
6. The removal of goods to the exhibition site shall be allowed under the supervision of Customs and JSHQ escort staff after observing due care without examination at the Wharves/ Airport. Custom's escort shall be provided by the concerned Assistant Collector Wharves/Airport. The Customs staff posted at exit gates of wharves / Airport will not only ensure that the seals of the containers are intact but will also record the exit time and other particulars of the consignment after verifying the Marks & Nos. in case of Packages and Seal/Container nos. in case of containerized Cargo.
7. The site for exhibition purpose shall be supervised by the Collectorate of Appraisement. It will also serve as the Coordinating Collectorate amongst all the concerned Collectorates.
8. The Customs Agent shall present the goods firm-wise for the examination. Examination shall be carried out 100% at the Exhibition Site in the presence of Customs Agent and the representative of JSHQ. The complete examination report shall be recorded on the reverse side of the Bill of Entry by the Customs Staff. This report shall be duly signed by the Customs Agent and the representative of JSHQ. The Customs staff shall also sign the inventory sheet prepared by the representative of JSHQ.

9. On the conclusion of the Exhibition, the Customs Agent will prepare a list of such goods indication description, quantity and value for final accountal and file Bill of Export for the goods to be exported alongwith invoice and packing list. The goods shall be verified by the representative of JSHQ with the inward inventory. The Customs staff after 100% examination as per procedure in vogue in the Export Collectorate shall allow export, if found in order with the inventory. The export inventory prepared by JSHQ shall be signed by the Customs Staff. The consignments shall be allowed export subject to the clearance from Drug Enforcement Cell, Preventive Collectorate, Karachi.
10. Before exportation, the processed bills of export will be presented to the Appraising Group of the respective Collectorate for reconciliation.
11. In case of items not exported within 20 days, the same will be treated as Defense Goods and shall be handed over to the Army Embarkation Headquarters Karachi. The EHQ shall follow the procedure laid down for clearance of Defense Cargo before removal from the Exhibition Area.
12. All imported live ammunition to be used during firepower display at PAF Firing Range Sonmiani will be consigned in the name of Embarkation Head Quarters and will be treated as Defense Cargo. Procedure already laid down for clearance of live Ammunition will be strictly followed.
13. In case of passengers arriving with the exhibition equipment, the same shall be allowed release by the Customs Staff at the Airport on the Authorization Certificate issued by the JSHQ and after due endorsement on their passports. The details of these goods shall be recorded at the exhibition area immediately after their arrival at KEC by the Customs, JSHQ & Custom's Agent. At the time of departure, the Customs staff at the airport shall delete the endorsement from passport in the light of Certificate of clearance issued by JSHQ after the fulfillment of formalities of immigration.
14. The goods imported for IDEAS-2000 will not be subject to warehousing surcharge nor they will be liable to Export Development Surcharge at the time of their export.
15. All the concerned Collectorates shall depute exclusive staff for escort and examination of goods at the Exhibition premises. However, the premises shall be supervised and manned by the Collectorate of Appraisement, Karachi round the clock.
16. The concerned Collectorates shall maintain a complete record of imports for IDEAS 2000, and PRAL shall provide Computer Terminal and develop necessary software if required at the Exhibition Site.
17. In case locally manufactured goods or duty paid goods are brought into the KEC, the details of such goods shall be maintained separately by the Customs and JSHQ. Such goods shall be allowed for sale. The organizers of IDEAS 2000, namely M/S Pegasus Consultancy (Pvt.) Ltd. shall maintain all record of such sales. The Customs and JSHQ staff at the KEC shall allow release of such goods during or after the exhibition subject to verification as per the inward inventory.
