CUSTOMS GENERAL ORDER NO. 06/2000

Subject :- STORAGE AND DISPOSAL OF SEIZED GOODS BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES INCLUDING CIVIL ARMED FORCES OF PAKISTAN WHO HAVE BEEN DELEGATED ANTI-SMUGGLING POWERS UNDER THE CUSTOMS ACT, 1969.

The Central Board of Revenue is pleased to order that the following amendment shall be made in Customs General Order No. 43/1999 dated 26.10.1999, namely:-

In the aforesaid C.G.O:-

1. For sub-para (viii) of para 10, the following sub-para shall be substituted:-

(VIII) ***Arms and Ammunition***:- Arms and Ammunition of prohibited and non-prohibited bores will be handed over to the respective seizing agency having anti-smuggling powers for their official use. Collectors of Customs will ensure that no delay is caused and the confiscated arms and ammunition ripe for disposal are handed over to the seizing agency.
