CUSTOMS GENERAL ORDER NO.18 OF 2000.

SUBJECT:- **PROCEDURE FOR EXPEDITIOUS CLEARANCE OF THE VEHICLES AT THE TIME OF IMPORTATION FOR USE IN EXPORT PROCESSING ZONES.**

The Central Board of Revenue is pleased to direct that the following further amendment shall be made in its Customs General Order No.1/1983 dated the 9th January, 1983, namely:-

In the aforesaid Customs General Order, in sub-paragraph (2), after the word "responsible" at the end, the following proviso shall be added, namely:-

"Provided that the vehicles imported by Zone investors would be allowed to be disposed off after five years of their import and usage and on leviable duties on the depreciated value of the vehicles as allowed to privileged persons."
