

The Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) has been mandated to ensure transparency, economy, efficiency and accountability of the public sector procuring agencies / organizations through monitoring and implementation of Public Procurement Rules, 2004. It is encouraging to note that since implementation of these rules the rate of violations of these rules has decreased substantially. However, procuring agencies do not strictly follow some of these rules in letter and spirit.

2. These Rules require all procuring agencies to devise a mechanism, for annual planning in detail for all proposed procurements with the object to realistically determine the requirements of the procuring agency within its available resources, delivery time, completion date and benefits that are likely to accrue to the procuring agency and shall proceed accordingly. The annual requirements so determined are also required to be advertised in advance on the Authority's website and on the website of Procuring Agency, if it has its own.

3. in view of above, it would be appreciated that the organizations under the administrative control of your Ministry are directed to ensure compliance of Rule 8 and 9 of the Public Procurement Rules, 2004 and furnish their proposed annual requirements of the financial year 2012 -13 for placing on Authority's website, at the earliest.
