
NOTIFICATION

S.R.O. ⁷⁷¹(1) / 2012.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 25 of the Civil Servants Act, 1973 (LXXI of 1973), read with Notification No. S.R.O. 120 (1)/98, dated the 27th February, 1998, the Prime Minister is pleased to direct that the following further amendment shall be made in the Government Servants (Conduct) Rules, 1964, namely:-

In the aforesaid Rules, after rule 13 the following new rule shall be inserted, namely:-

“13A. Assets to be made public. — The assets of all those who are paid from the Government exchequer shall be made public.”
