The office of Additional Registrar (Judicial) of the Court had issued several notices to the Commissioner Inland Revenue Legal (Legal Wing), RTO, Peshawar but no one has appeared.</p> <p>2. This is not the first case but we are confronted with numerous cases with regard to the Revenue Department which are either poorly conducted or none take any interest to defend the</p>

public exchequer which they are under legal obligation to do.

Left with no alternative we direct to attach the monthly salary of the Collector of Sale Tax and issue a bailable warrant of arrest against him in the sum of Rs.30,000/- with two sureties in the like amount to appear alongwith the relevant record on 30-9-2010.
