

Through this application the applicant/respondents seeks vacation of injunctive order dated 24.10.2012 which reads as under:-


“Adjourned to 8.11.2012. Till then no coercive measures shall be adopted against the petitioner.”

2. We have carefully gone through the injunctive order. It is date specific. It has not been extended. Moreover, in view of the provisions of Article 199 (4)(a) of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973 the interim order made by High Court that relates to assessment of collection of public revenue shall cease to have effect on the expiration of a period of six months following the day on which it was made. In view of these provisions of law, no specific order for vacating the injunctive order is required to be passed. This application stands decided.
