

**SETTLEMENT OF DUTY/TAXES BY  
NATIONAL BANK OF PAKISTAN ON 30<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER, 2014**

This is with reference to the FBR letter D.O. No. 1(8) Rev Bud/2014 dated September 24, 2014 (copy attached) on the above subject and SBP's subsequent instructions issued, vide letter NO.FD.GOV/1140/87-2013 dated November 28, 2013.

In this regard, it is advised to ensure compliance of the following operational instructions for 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2014 with regard to settlement/clearing of FBR transactions on month end.

- The NBP branches (A, B&C) will settle their transactions on same day i.e. 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2014 with respective SBP BSC Offices for which a special clearing will be arranged at 03:00 pm by NIFT and NBP will settle the transactions with SBP BSC by 09:00 pm.
- Further, the NBP branches (A, B, & C) will conduct cash and NBP customer transaction for tax payers till 8:00 pm on 29<sup>th</sup> September, 2014 and 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2014.

Please ensure meticulous compliance of the above.
