

(I)/2009.— In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 18 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), the Federal Government is pleased to direct that a regulatory duty at the rate of twenty-five per cent *ad valorem* shall be levied on export of goods classifiable under the H.S. codes specified in the Table below:

Provided that no regulatory duty shall be levied on export of goods made from the material imported under the facility of DTRE as provided under sub-chapter 7 of Chapter XII of the Customs Rules, 2001 or the scheme of manufacturing bonds as licensed under Chapter XV of the said Rules.


