CIRCULAR

Subject: Maintenance of Record of Casual Leave

Under the existing orders of the Federal Government, Casual Leave upto maximum period of 20 days is permissible in a calendar year. Although Casual Leave cannot be claimed as a matter of right, it should be granted invariably unless the presence of an officer is absolutely necessary, there is an official emergency or very extraordinary official circumstances exist.

- 2. The record of Casual Leave is required to be maintained by all offices, so as to ensure no officer/official avails Casual Leave exceeding the maximum limit of 20 days in a calendar year.
- 3. The Chairman, FBR/Revenue Secretary has directed that every Supervisory Officer in FBR(HQ) and its field formations should ensure that the record of Casual Leave of all officers/officials working in the office is properly maintained.
- 4. All officers while sanctioning Casual Leave to the officers/officials will issue proper order and endorse copies to respective HR Manager in field formations and for FBR(Hqrs) to respective Chief (HRM-IR)/Chief (HRM-Customs) for maintenance of record.
