I am directed to say that this Ministry intends to fill the vacant post of Science Counsellor (BS-19) a post of Ministry of Science and Technology, in the Embassy of Pakistan, Beijing (China) under the new Policy Guidelines issued by Establishment Division vide O.M. No. 4/3/2016-T-IV dated 21st October, 2021. The following points may be taken into consideration while nominating officers for the subject post:-

- (a) The nominee fulfils the requirements of the post as detailed in the Job Description (**Annex-I**).
- (b) The nominee has an overall good record of service with no disciplinary actions pending against him.
- (c) The nominee is M.Sc. Natural Sciences/Applied Science or B.Sc. Engineering.
- (d) Those likely to retire during the next 4 years will not be considered.
- (e) Nominees having familiarity with diplomatic channels will be preferred.
- (f) Experience in bilateral collaboration is desired.
- (g) Nominees who have been posted abroad within the last 3 years will not be considered.

2. All Organizations under administrative control of MoST other than the academic institutions are requested to send nominations of suitable BS-19 officers to Ministry of Science & Technology by **15th March, 2021**, alongwith following complete documents (in duplicate):-

- (i) Bio-data.
- (ii) PER synopsis for the last five years.
- (iii) A certificate to the effect that no disciplinary proceedings are pending against the nominee

3- Incomplete nominations and those received after due date will not be entertained.

JOB DESCRIPTION FOR THE POST OF SCIENCE COUNSELLOR

- Submitting regular reports on follow-up and implementation of the Protocol of the 18th session under the framework of Agreement on Scientific and Technological cooperation 1976
- Submit reports on policy level reforms implemented in China for its National Innovation System that has contributed to China's socio-economic development
- Submit reports on R&D funding mechanisms in China and make recommendations for Pakistan vis-à-vis industry academia linkages for development of science and technology
- Submit reports on China's role in multi-lateral fora on science and technology and make recommendations enabling Pakistan to explore such opportunities
- Submit reports on opportunities for Pakistan S&T along with recommendations out of CPEC and OBOR initiatives
- Submit report alongwith recommendations on twining of Pakistani and Chinese S&T institutions for exchange of expertise, technology and scientific knowledge
- Seek opportunities in China for training of Pakistan scientists through scholarships and sponsorships and submitting regular reports to this Ministry
- Develop contacts with scientific and technological enterprises in China to explore opportunities for Chinese investment in R&D in Pakistan
- Liaison with this Ministry while collecting and disseminating information to relevant stakeholders in Pakistan on science and technology developments in China and making suitable recommendations to Pakistani counterparts
- Submit regular reports on best practices adopted in China for cooperation in the field of science and technology between developed and developing countries
