Consequent upon the recommendation of the Federal Public Service Commission, Islamabad conveyed vide letter No. F.4-178/2018-R-FS-I dated 15.12.2022, the following candidate(s) who have furnished medical fitness certificate(s) are offered appointment of the post of Inspector Customs/ Intelligence Officer (BS-16) in the Pakistan Customs Department under Federal Board of Revenue, Islamabad:-

- 2. The terms and conditions of appointment are briefly as follow:
 - i) The new incumbent Inspector Customs / Intelligence Officers will be entitled to draw pay in the Basic Pay Scale (BPS-16) i.e. Rs.28070-2260-95870 and usual allowances as admissible under the rules.
 - ii) They will be on probation for a period of one year extendable by further period not exceeding one year provided that if no order is made on the expiry of the first year of probation period, the probation shall be deemed to have been extended for a further period of one year; provided further that if no order is made by the date following the term of extended period of probation, the probation shall be deemed as terminated. Appointment on probation shall be subject to the provisions of Section 6 of the Civil Servants Act, 1973.
 - iii) As a probationer, and after the termination of probation, their services shall be subject to the provisions of the Civil Servants Act, 1973 and the rules made thereunder.
 - iv) The services will be liable to be terminated in accordance with Section 11 of the Civil Servants Act, 1973.
 - v) This offer of appointment is provisional and shall be subject to fulfillment of following conditions during the probation period:
 - a. Verification of Character and Antecedents.
 - b. Verification of Academic documents, Domicile etc.
 - c. Final medical fitness certificate as prescribed.
 - vi) They shall be required to complete the requisite training to the satisfaction of the head of training institutions where they will undergo the training.

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- vii) They will be liable to serve anywhere within or outside Pakistan in any post under the Federal Government or a Provincial Government or a local authority established by any such government. However, they are advised to convey 1st, 2nd and 3rd option / choice of the posting station i.e. Islamabad / Gilgit-Baltistan/ Punjab / Sindh/ Balochistan/ Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.
- viii) In case they are already in service of any Government department / autonomous body etc. and have applied for the post through proper channel, they should get themselves relieved from their employer before joining the post.
- 3. If the said terms and conditions of appointment are accepted, willingness to this effect may be sent to the undersigned within 10 days of receipt of this offer of appointment letter. The written acceptance should be forwarded through Courier Service / U.M.S / Registered post.
- 4. This offer of appointment will be treated as withdrawn if acceptance is not conveyed within 10 days.
- 5. <u>Notification of appointment/ posting will be issued only on receipt of acceptance of offer of appointment.</u>
- 6. No TA/DA will be admissible for joining the post.
