Subject:

Cyber Security Advisory - Australian Team Visit to Pakistan (Advisory No. 09)

1. In the wake of Australian Cricket team visit to Pakistan, HIAs may disrupt / sabotage the visit by utilizing cyber means. In this regard guidelines given below must be strictly adhered by security managers to ensure successful completion of visit:-

a. Use of Smart Phones

- Smart Phones should not be used by troops deployed on security.
 A weak security posture of Smartphone may leverage and allow HIAs to conduct surveillance by remotely turning on GPS, microphone and Camera.
- 2. Travel with simple cell phones as these eliminate risk of phone becoming a backdoor.
- Location settings to be turned off for all apps installed on phones.
- Exercise caution when surfing web and beware of phishing threats.
- No posts / pictures in exuberance be posted on SM platforms by Security Troops / Protocol Staff.

b. General Precautions

- Enable multifactor authentication on all SM platforms and devices.
- Sensitive data to be kept encrypted in phones / digital devices.
- Passwords and banking credentials should not be shared over public Wi-Fi.
- Do not click on any unexpected link or install any application from third party.
- 5. Immediately report any unusual activity to higher authorities.
