Subject: **RE-DETERMINATION OF CUSTOMS VALUE FOR HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES AND PARTS UNDER SECTION 25A OF THE CUSTOMS ACT, 1969.**

Kindly refer to the above subject.

2. The Directorate General of Customs Valuation Karachi has initiated an exercise for the re-determination of customs values of subject goods notified vide **Valuation Ruling No. 1898/2024 dated 05.07.2024**. This exercise has been undertaken in accordance with the provisions of Section 25A of the Customs Act, 1969, with the objective of ensuring fair, transparent, and up-to-date assessment of customs values in line with prevailing international market trends.

3. The meeting has been scheduled on **17.12.2025 at 12:00 noon** in the Conference Hall, 7th Floor, Custom House, Karachi. The meeting will be chaired by the Director/Additional Director, Directorate General of Customs Valuation Karachi. All relevant stakeholders, including importers, representatives of trade bodies, and other concerned parties, are invited to attend the meeting. The Stakeholders are also requested to bring along their written submissions, duly supported by documentary evidence such as:

- Import invoices and Goods Declarations (GDs).
- Copies of Letters of Credit (LCs) or contracts.
- International price or references.
- Manufacturer/exporter price lists or catalogues.
- Market survey data, if available.

- Any other supporting documents.

4. The purpose of this meeting is to review all relevant market information and trade data to facilitate the re-determination of customs values in a fair, equitable, and evidence-based manner. Stakeholders' participation and cooperation in providing accurate data and constructive input will assist the Directorate in finalizing values that reflect prevailing market conditions and maintain transparency in the valuation process. It is, therefore, requested that all concerned stakeholders ensure their presence in the meeting on the scheduled date and time, along with the requisite documents and written submissions. Non-attendance shall be deemed, as having no objection to the proceedings.
