Petitioner is aggrieved of the order/ notification dated 13.08.2024, in wake of denial of Conveyance Allowance, Performance Allowance and FBR Fixed Incentive, which allowances were available to the employees on duty. Through order under reference aforementioned three allowance were declared inadmissible for widow / family of the deceased.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner refers to order dated 08.01.2018 of Honourable Supreme Court of Pakistan in Civil Petition No.1161 AND 1267/2017 titled "Federation of Pakistan. Vs. Salma Bibi & others". No assistance could be claimed from the decision referred. It is otherwise illogical to assume that Conveyance Allowance and Performance Allowance or Fixed Incentive could be claimed by the family of the deceased employee. Learned counsel complains of discriminatory treatment. This Court is not allegation of inclined to inquire into discrimination. Petitioner is at liberty to raise grievance before the Authorities concerned.
