Notification

In pursuance of Cabinet Division's Notification No. No.7-2/2026-Min.I and the meeting held with Heads of all field offices in the evening of 9th March, 2026, the Chairman, FBR is pleased to constitute the following Committee for implementation of the additional austerity and conservation measures:

1. Chief Admn/Finance
2. Chief (IR-Operations)
3. Chief (Customs-Operations)

2. The Additional Austerity and Conservation Committee shall have the following TORs:

- (a) The Committee shall ensure that all the directions of the Federal Government for additional austerity and conservation measures are implemented in letter and spirit.
- (b) The respective Chiefs of Operations shall ensure that 60% of official vehicles in the field offices are immediately parked across all the field formations.
- (c) The Chief (A&F) shall ensure that 60% vehicles in FBR HQ are immediately parked in FBR HQ and the Directorates Generals which are not reporting to Operations Wing.
- (d) The Chief(A&F) shall ensure that 50% cut on fuel expenses is immediately imposed across all the field offices and FBR(HQ).

- (e) The Chief(A&F) shall seek voluntary foregoing of two days' salary from all BS-20 and above officers.
- (f) Chief(A&F) and Secretary (Expenditure) shall ensure that Non-ERE budget for the 4th Quarter is slashed by 20% and the releases are made accordingly.
- (g) Chief(A&F) shall also ensure complete ban on purchase of durables in coordination with field offices.
- (h) The Committee shall collectively ensure that work from home are implemented for up to 50% staff with immediate effect commencing from 10th March, 2026.
- (i) The Chief(A&F) shall also issue directions that speed limits for official vehicles on roads is maintained at the maximum level as provided in the above referred notification of the Cabinet Division.
- (j) The Committee shall ensure that all other directions on the additional austerity and conservation measures are strictly adhered to.

3. The Additional Austerity and Conservation Committee shall submit compliance report to Member Admn/HR and respective Members of Operations on 11 March, 2026, to be followed by a weekly implementation report on every Monday.

4. All heads of FBR HQ wings and field offices shall promptly respond to, and implement, the directions of the Committee.
