Subject: REDETERMINATION OF CUSTOMS VALUES FOR “POLYESTER FILAMENT YARN” UNDER SECTION 25A OF THE CUSTOMS ACT, 1969.

2. The Directorate General of Customs Valuation Karachi has initiated an exercise for re-determination of customs values of subject goods. This exercise has been undertaken in accordance with the provisions of Section 25A of the Customs Act, 1969, with the objective of ensuring fair, transparent, and up-to-date assessment of customs values in line with prevailing international market trends.

3. The meeting earlier scheduled for 30-06-2026 has been **rescheduled** on **23-06-2026** on **12:30 PM** in the Conference Hall, 7th Floor, Custom House, Karachi. The meeting will be chaired by the Director/Additional Director, Directorate General of Customs Valuation Karachi. All relevant stakeholders, including importers, representatives of trade bodies, and other concerned parties, are invited to attend the meeting. The Stakeholders are also requested to bring their written submissions, duly supported by documentary evidences such as:

- Import invoices and Goods Declarations (GDs).
- Copies of Letters of Credit (LCs) or contracts.
- International price or references.
- Manufacturer/exporter price lists or catalogues.
- Market survey data, if available.
- Any other supporting documents.

4. The purpose of this meeting is to review all relevant market information and trade data to facilitate the determination of customs values in a fair, equitable, and evidence-based manner.

Stakeholders' participation and cooperation in providing accurate data and constructive input will assist the Directorate in finalizing values that reflect prevailing market conditions and maintain transparency in the valuation process. It is, therefore, requested that all concerned stakeholders to ensure their presence in the meeting on the scheduled date and time, along with the requisite documents and written submissions. Non-attendance shall be deemed as having no objection to the proceedings.
