Subject: AWARENESS CAMPAIGN REGARDING MANDATORY USE OF SAFETY HELMETS BY MOTORCYCLISTS.

It is respectfully submitted that a significant number of road traffic accidents in the Islamabad Capital Territory involve motorcyclists who fail to wear safety helmets while riding, resulting in avoidable fatalities and serious injuries.
