2. The Directorate General of Customs Valuation Karachi has initiated an exercise for the determination of customs values for the subject goods, according to current international prices. This exercise has been undertaken in accordance with the provisions of Section 25A of the Customs Act, 1969, with the objective of ensuring fair, transparent, and up-to-date assessment of customs values in line with prevailing international market trends.
3. The meeting has been scheduled for **24.09.2026 at 12:00 (noon)** in Conference Hall, 7th Floor, Custom House, Karachi. The meeting will be chaired by the Director/Additional Director, Directorate General of Customs Valuation Karachi. All relevant stakeholders, representatives of trade bodies, and other parties concerned, are invited to attend the meeting. The Stakeholders are also requested to bring their written submissions, duly supported by documentary evidence.
4. The purpose of this meeting is to review all relevant market information and trade data to facilitate the determination of customs values in a fair, equitable, and evidence-based manner. Stakeholders' participation and cooperation in providing accurate information and constructive input will assist the Directorate in finalizing values that reflect prevailing market conditions and maintain transparency in the valuation process. It is, therefore, requested that all concerned stakeholders ensure their presence at the meeting at the time of the scheduled date and time, along with the relevant documents and written submissions. Non-attendance shall be deemed as having no objection to the proceedings.
5. The trade bodies and representative associations are further requested to circulate this meeting notice amongst their respective relevant members and invite them to attend the meeting.
