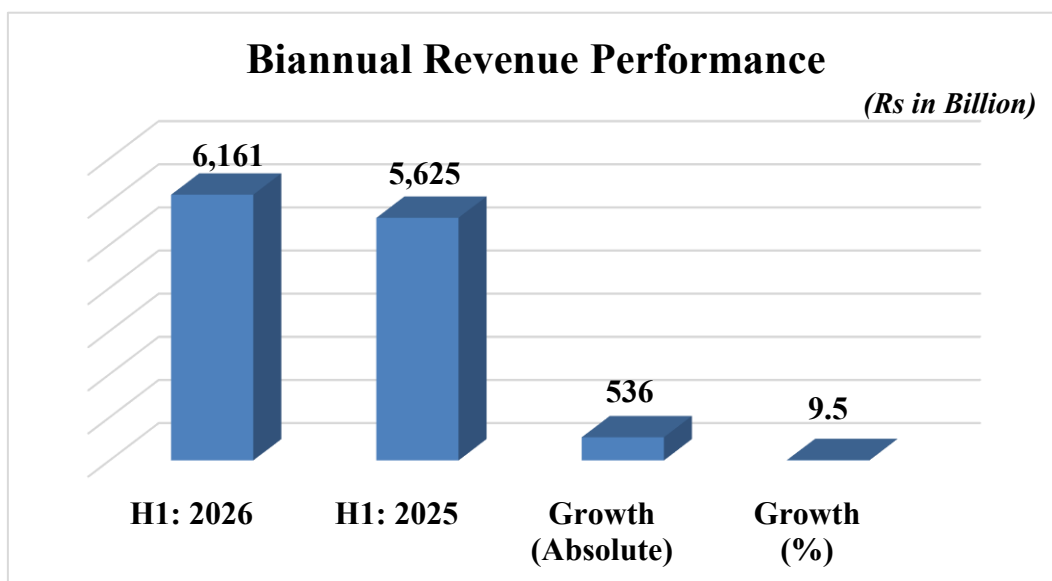

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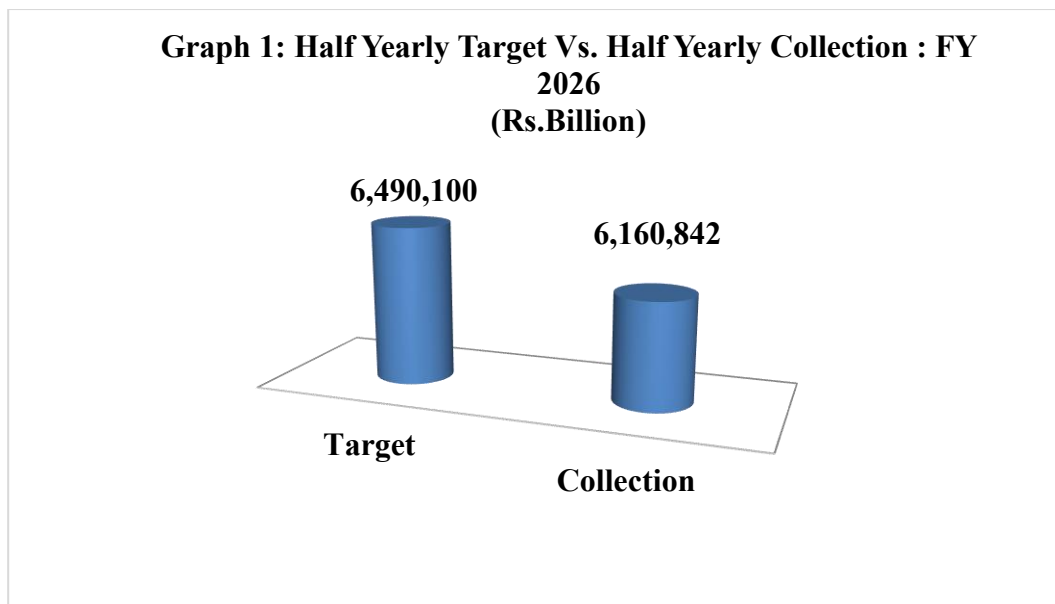

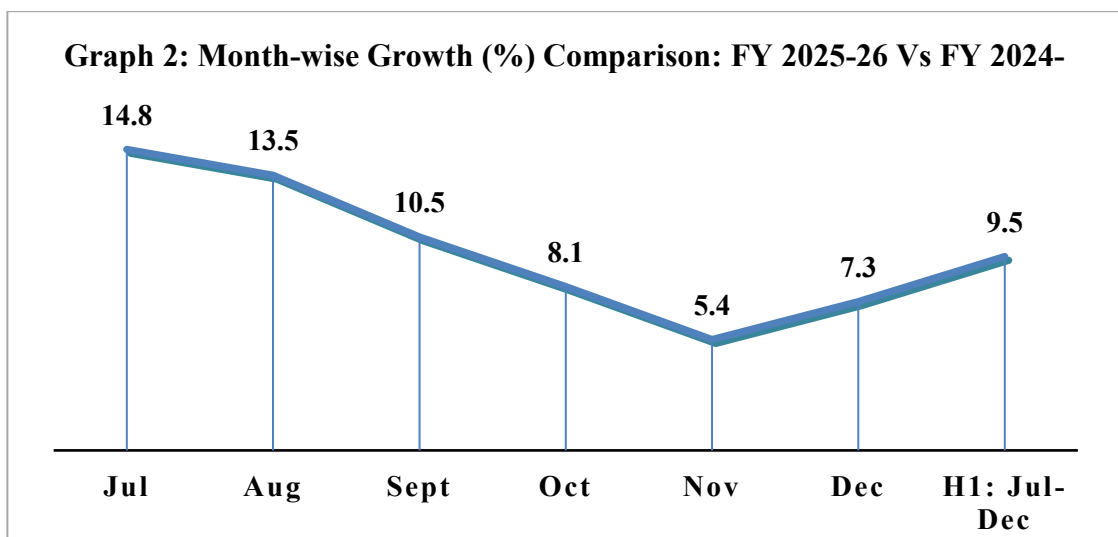
SYNOPSIS BIANNUAL (JULY-DECEMBER FY 2025-26)

Overall, FBR's tax collection during first half of FY 2025-26 was increased by **Rs. 536.0 billion** or **9.5%** over the corresponding period of FY 2024-24 (Graph-2).

For the month of December 2025-26, FBR collected revenues worth **Rs. 1,427.2 billion** against the target of **Rs. 1,445.5 billion**. Collection increased by **7.3%** over the corresponding period of FY 2024-25 (Graph 1).

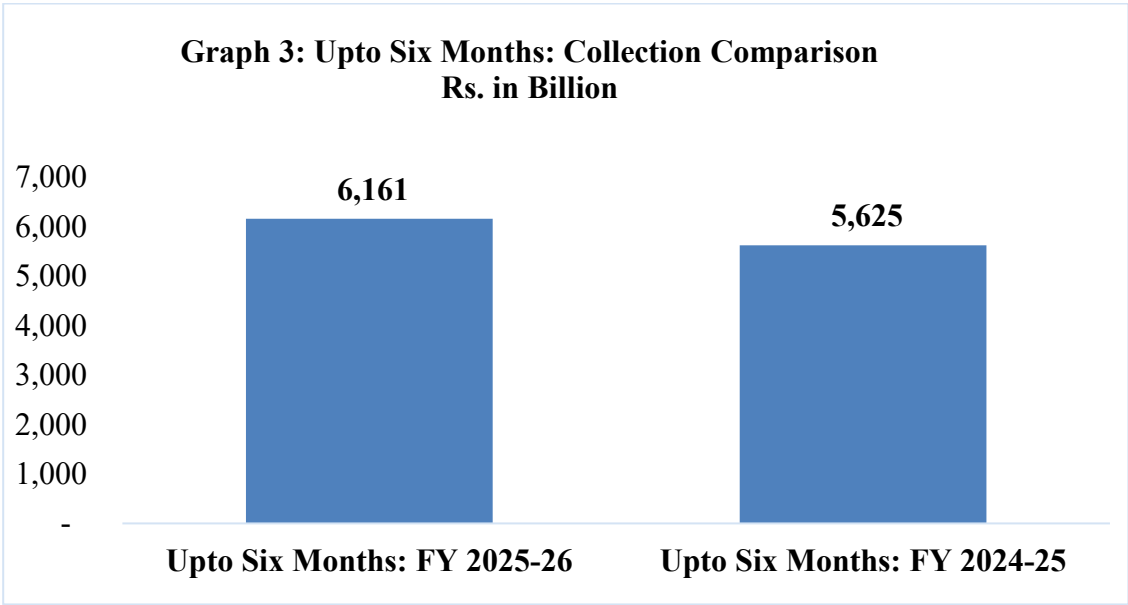

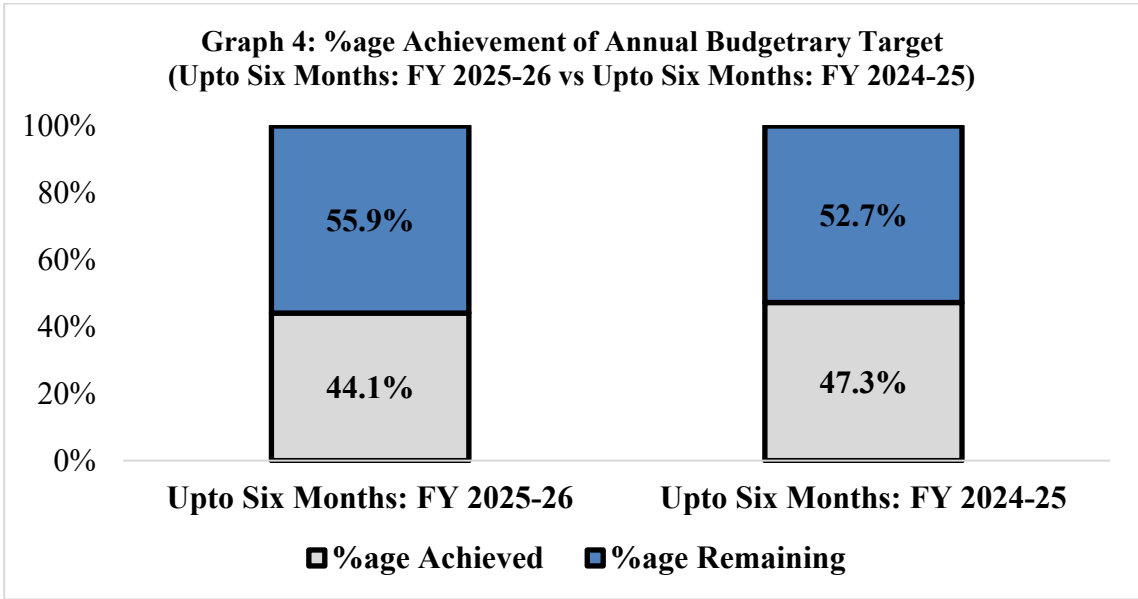

During the six months of FY 2025-26, FBR has managed to collect **Rs. 6,161** Billion against **Rs. 5,624.9** Billion collected in six months FY 2024-25, showing growth of **9.5%**. In absolute terms, **Rs. 536** Billion was additionally collected in the six months of FY 2025-26, compared to collection in six months of FY 2024-25 (Graph-3).



In six months of FY 2025-26 approximately 44.1% of the total annual budgetary target has been achieved, compared to 47.3% achievement of the total annual budgetary target in six months of FY 2024-25 (Graph-4).



Tax-wise Performance

Direct Tax

- July-December FBR collection increased by **9.5%**
- Direct Tax collection increased by **8.9%** or **Rs. 248.8 billion** over the corresponding period of PFY.
- During H1: FY 2026, Direct Tax collection increased by **8.9%** over the corresponding period of PFY.

Sales Tax

- Overall Sales Tax collection increased by **10.0%** or **Rs.189.0 billion**. While Sales Tax from Imports increased by **22.8%** the Sales Tax Domestic decline by **7.1%**.
- During H1: FY 2026, Sales Tax collection increased by **10.0%**. While Sales Tax Domestic decline by **7.1%** and Sales Tax Import increased by **22.8%**.

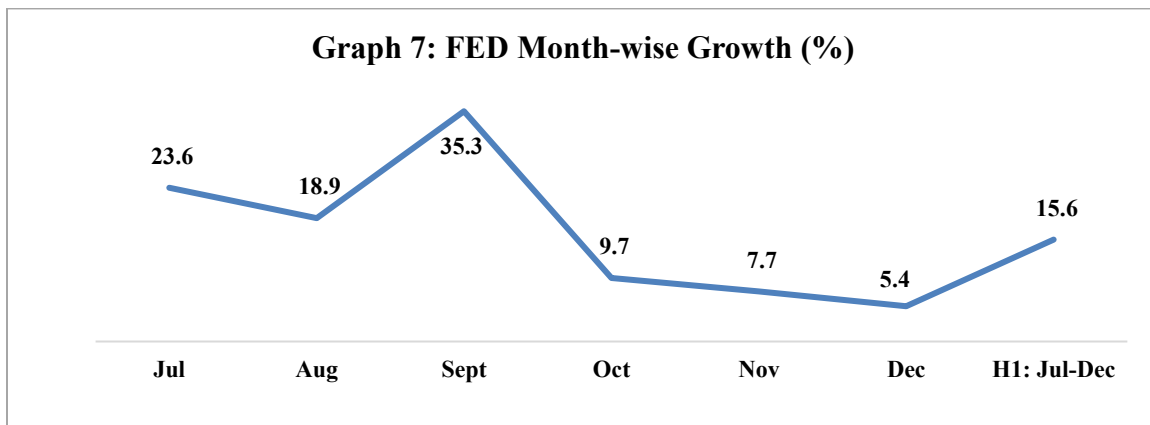
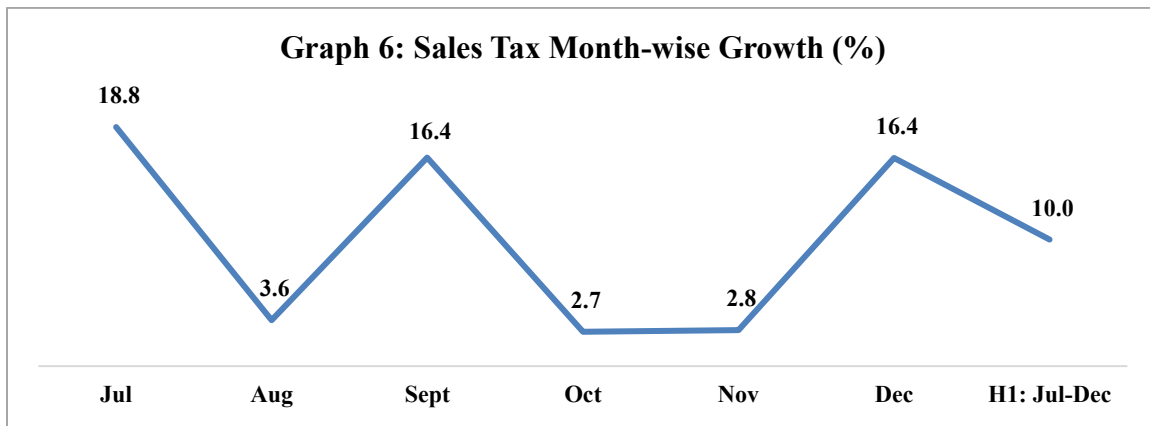
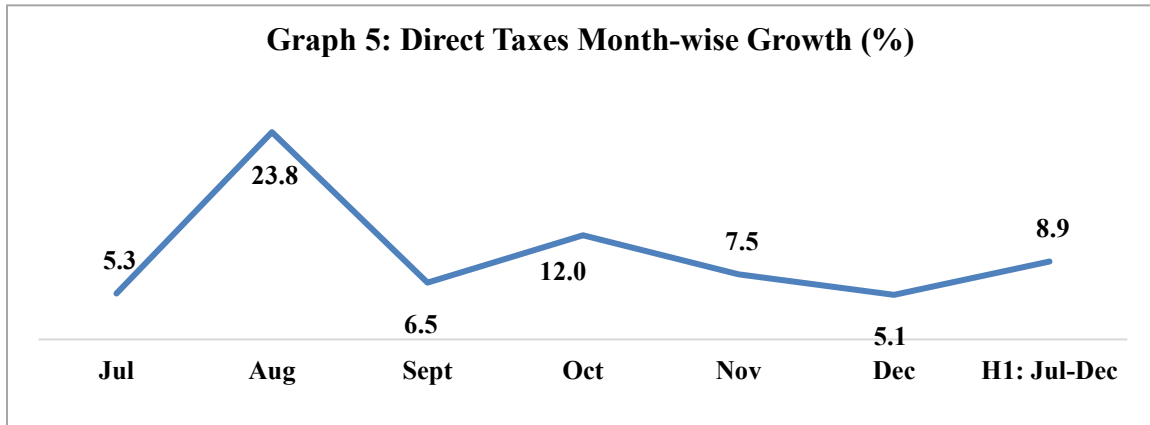
- Collection increased by **15.6%** or **Rs.54.2 billion** over the corresponding period of PFY.
- During H1: FY 2026, FED collection increased by **15.6%** over the corresponding period of PFY.

Customs

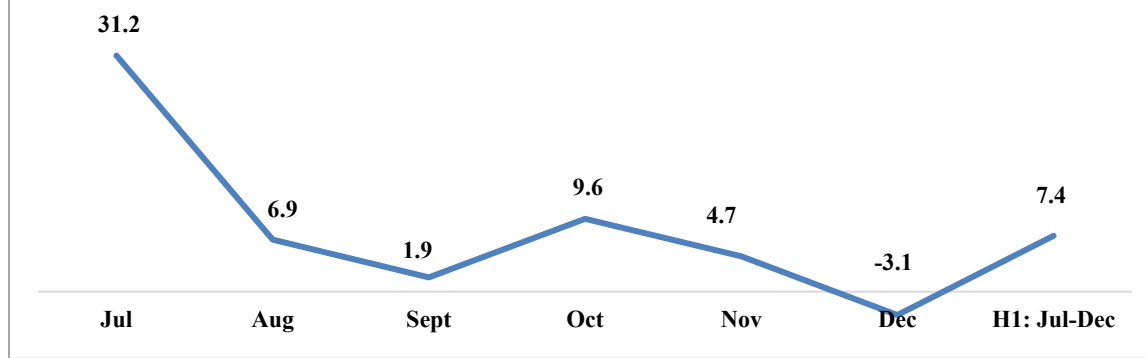
- Collection increased by **7.4%** or **R7.44.1 billion** over the corresponding period of FY.
- During H1: FY 2026, Customs Duty collection increased by **7.4%** over the corresponding period of PFY.
