S.R.O.1074(I)/2008.— In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3DD of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), and section 30 and 31 of Sales Tax Act, 1990, the Federal Board of Revenue is pleased to notify the formation of the Directorate of Post Clearance Audit, Karachi, and appoint, namely:—

- (a) the officer specified in column (2) of the Table below to be the Director of the Post Clearance Audit, Karachi for the areas and functions specified in corresponding column (3) thereof; and
- (b) the Additional Directors, Deputy Directors, Assistant Directors, Principal Appraisers, Senior Auditors, Appraisers, Deputy Superintendents, to be the respective officers of Customs of those areas.

Area of Functional Jurisdiction

- (i) All imports, into and exports from, Pakistan routed and cleared by any cargo clearance system including temporary imports.
- (ii) All matters including imports, temporary imports of all sorts including imports under concessionary notifications, DTRE Scheme, transshipment, transit and warehousing.
- (iii) Bulk oil imports.
- (iv) Public and Private Warehouses.
- (v) Export rebates.

- (vi) Warehouses including manufacturing warehouses.
 - (vii) Baggage.
 - (viii) any area of functional jurisdiction as declared by the Board.
