**NOTIFICATION
(Customs)**

S.R.O. 1075(I)/2008.— In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3DD of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), and section 30 and 31 of Sales Tax Act, 1990, the Federal Board of Revenue is pleased to notify the formation of the Directorate of Post Clearance Audit, Lahore, and appoint,—

- (a) the officer specified in column (2) of the Table below to be the Director of the Central Office, Post Clearance Audit, for the areas and functions specified in corresponding column (3) thereof; and
- (b) the Additional Directors, Deputy Directors, Assistant Directors, Principal Appraisers, Senior Auditors, Appraisers, Deputy Superintendents, to be the respective officers of Customs of those areas.

1	Director, Post Clearance Audit, Lahore.	The jurisdiction of the Office, PCA would extend to relevant jurisdiction covering all Customs transactions relating imports, exports and allied functions, taking place through any cargo clearance system through all Collectorates at Lahore, Rawalpindi, Multan, Faisalabad, (Sambrial) Sialkot and Peshawar covering the following areas of Customs operations, namely :— (a) all imports and exports into Pakistan routed and cleared by any cargo clearance system including temporary imports; (b) all imports and exports effected through One Customs or any other clearance system;

- (c) all matters including imports, temporary imports of all sorts including imports under concessionary notifications, DTRE Scheme, transshipment, transit and warehousing;
 - (d) bulk oil imports;
 - (e) Public and Private Warehouses.
 - (f) export rebates;
 - (g) warehouses including manufacturing warehouses;
 - (h) baggage; and
 - (i) or any area of territorial or functional jurisdictions as declared by the Board.
