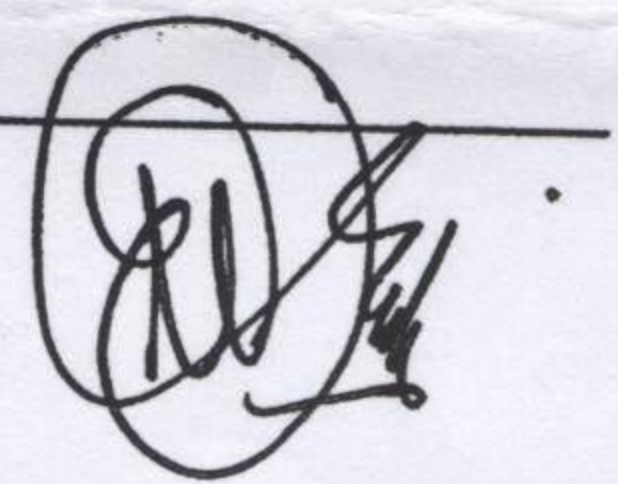
**NOTIFICATION
(CUSTOMS & FEDERAL EXCISE)**

S.R.O. 165 (I)/2011.— In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 29 of the Federal Excise Act, 2005, the Federal Board of Revenue is pleased to direct that the officers, specified in column (2) of the Table below, of the Directorate-General of Post Clearance Audit established under section 3DD of the Customs Act, 1969, shall exercise the powers of officers of Inland Revenue, specified in column (3) of the said Table, in relation to any case of import or class of cases of import, as vested under the provisions specified in column (4) thereof namely: —
