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Invitation for Bids

<b>Brief Description of Goods:</b>	Supply of Furniture for DOT, Customs Islamabad, Refurbishment of Conference Room at CDA Block -3, and supply of library Books.

The Government of Pakistan has received credit from the International Development Association towards the cost of **Tax Administration Reform Project** and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to payments under the contract for up-gradation of Directorates of Trainings (DOTs) for Customs and Inland Revenue (IR), Islamabad as per following Lots:

- Lot 1:** Supply of Furniture for DOT Customs, Islamabad.
- Lot 2:** Furnishing of Conference Room for DOT, IR, Islamabad
- Lot 3:** Library Books for DOTs Customs and IR Lahore, Karachi & Islamabad.

2. The Federal Board of Revenue now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders with minimum bid security of 2% of bid price for respective lots. Bidders may bid for any one or more lots. Evaluation of bids and award of contract will be lot-wise.
3. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from the Federal Board of Revenue and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 0900 to 1500 hours.
4. A complete set of bidding documents in *English* may be purchased by interested bidders by submitting a written application at the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee equivalent to **Pak Rs. 1000/-**. The method of payment will be direct deposit under Federal Government of Pakistan Head of Account C-03870-Non tax receipts-others. Interested Bidders who wish to receive the Bidding Documents through courier should provide an additional amount of Rs. 300/- for delivery within Pakistan. A **Pre-bid Meeting**, with the perspective bidders will be held at 11:00 hours on **30.07.2011**.
5. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **11:00 hours on 15.08.2011**. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in the shape of

DD/Pay Order/CDR or Bank Guarantee which shall remain valid for a period of 121 days after Bids opening. *Late bids* will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below at 1130 hours, on **15.08.2011**.

6. Price quoted shall be paid Delivered Duty Paid (DDP) including all applicable taxes/duties.
7. Bids shall be valid for period of (91) days after opening.
8. All Government Taxes shall be deducted as per law. Proof of registration with Income Tax Department and Sales Tax Department should be enclosed with the Bid.
9. Bidders are requested to give their best and final prices as no negotiations are allowed.
10. Bidders engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices (including collusion/polling) will be declared ineligible either indefinitely or for stated period of time for award of contracts finance by "**The World Bank**".
