Bidders Must Provide

1. Firm registration (on E-PADS, FBR, with valid NTN & Sales Tax registration)
2. Firm profile (address, landline, email, bank details, active tax status)
3. Experience: Minimum 3 years (proof of government supply orders from FY 2022–23 to 2024–25)
4. Financial Soundness: Bank statement with minimum Rs. 40 million balance (as of 30 June 2025)
5. Performance Certificates: From at least two government departments
6. No Blacklisting Affidavit: Rs.100 stamp paper declaration
7. Bid Security: 2% Pay Order uploaded and submitted physically
8. Stamped & Signed Documents: Uploaded and hard copies submitted

Evaluation & Award Process

- Bids are evaluated by the Procurement (Evaluation) Committee via E-PADS.
- Non-compliant or incomplete bids are marked non-responsive.
- Lowest or most advantageous bidder wins based on technical and financial compliance.
- Samples may be required for quality verification during the pre - bid meeting.

- After evaluation, Letter of Intent (LoI) is issued; contract signed within 14 days.

General Conditions

- All rates must be inclusive of all taxes.
- Prices remain fixed for FY 2025–26 (no escalation allowed).
- Substandard or damaged supplies will lead to replacement, forfeiture, and blacklisting.
- All communication and clarifications handled through E-PADS.
- Collectorate reserves the right to accept/reject bids or modify quantities.

The bids will be opened next day on 2nd January at 12:30 pm in the presence of bidders.
