1. The Federal Board of Revenue has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Pakistan Raises Revenue Program (PRRP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for procuring consulting services.
2. The consulting services (“the Services”) include physical and operational design of the RIAC capable of receiving and analyzing images from the different seaports, airports, border crossing points, and others, and sharing the findings onwards with Custom authorities ensuring full compliance with the TORs attached to this REOI.
3. The Terms of Reference (TOR) for the primary procurement stage for the assignment are attached to this request for expressions of interest and can be found at the following website: <https://fbr.gov.pk/tenders>.
4. The Federal Board of Revenue now invites eligible Consulting Firms ("Consultants"), to indicate their interest in providing the said Services. Interested Consultants should provide the information demonstrating that they have required qualification and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are:
 - a. Core Business and Years in Business:**
 - At least ten (10) years of post-registration advisory/ consulting experience with specialized skills in the designing of RIAC for Customs department in other countries offering similar services.
 - b. Relevant Experience:**
 - The Consultant should have experience in remote access and collaborative analysis workflows, as well as non-intrusive inspection technologies, including their image formats and analysis needs.
 - The Consultant should have experience of similar projects of similar scale and complexity in comparable organizations.

- c. **Technical and Managerial capability of the Firm:**
- The Consultant confirm that they have right managerial and technical staff along with experts to perform the Services.
 - In case of affiliation with a Global Professional Services firm, copy of affiliation document shall be provided.
- d. Confirmation of free of Conflict of Interest in accordance with Section III, paragraphs, 3.14, 3.16, and 3.17 of the World Bank’s “Procurement Regulations” as referred at Point# 5 below.
5. The attention of interested Consultant Firms is drawn to Section III, paragraphs, 3.14, 3.16, and 3.17 of the World Bank’s “Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers” July 2016 [revised November 2017 and August 2018] (“Procurement Regulations”), setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.
 6. Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.
 7. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost-Based Selection (QCBS) arrangements described in the Procurement Regulations and to be specifically set out in the Request for Proposals
 8. A virtual Information Session shall be held on 25th June, 2025 at 1130 Hours PST to familiarize the potential applicants on Terms of Reference (available at <https://fbr.gov.pk/tenders>) and ensuing procurement process.
