I am directed to refer to the IFB and Bidding Document published by the PMU-ITTMS dated 28th January 2026 for the subject procurement activity.

The Payment terms are explicitly defined at Page No. 8-80, Clause GCC 16.1 of Section 8: Special Conditions of Contract, of the bidding document. The provisions are reproduced below for ease of reference: Payment of the Contract Price shall be made in the following manner: As per the Payment Schedule mentioned below: For Goods supplied from outside or within the Purchaser's country: Payment shall be made in Pak. Rupees according to the following manner: (a) On Pre-shipment Inspection: The Purchaser shall pay the Supplier 20% of the Contract Price of the Goods, upon execution of Pre-shipment physical inspection of the goods/products to be supplied, by the designated representatives/committee of the Procuring Agency, confirming their acceptance in the form of "Pre-shipment Inspection Report" as per the process specified at GCC Clause 26 viz. Inspections and Tests, upon submission of claim with supporting documents by the Supplier, within thirty (30) days. (b) On Acceptance: 80% of the Contract Price of the goods & related services shall be paid within sixty (60) days when the supplies are delivered, verified, tested and necessary physical inspection & counting is executed, and accepted, at both delivery locations i.e., (i) Border Crossing Point Terminal – Torkham and (ii) Border Crossing Point Terminal – Chaman, upon submission of claim supported by the acceptance certificate issued by the Purchaser.
