Sealed tenders are invited from reputed suppliers, contractors, or firms registered with Income Tax and Sales Tax Departments for the supply of dry and perishable ration items required for the check post operating under the jurisdiction of the Collectorate of Customs Enforcement, Multan, for the Financial Years 2025-26.

SCOPE OF WORK

The successful bidder shall be responsible for the supply and delivery of ration items (dry and perishable) as per the approved list to various Customs Check Posts/Field Formations situated within the jurisdiction of Collectorate of Customs Enforcement, Multan including:

- Multan Division
- Bahawalpur Division
- Dera Ghazi Khan Division

- Wheat Flour
- Rice

Terms and Conditions

1. Interested bidders may apply online through e-PADS portal and submit their sealed bids (hardcopies) on the address given below by 11:00 am on 23.06.2026. These bids will be opened on the same day at 02.30pm in the Conference Room at the Ground Floor of Custom House, Multan in presence of the bidders.
2. The bidder must provide following documents:
 - Sales Tax Registration Certificate.
 - NTN Certificate.
 - Active Taxpayer Certificate / ATL Status.
 - Provincial Sales Tax Registration (if applicable)
 - CNIC of the authorized person.
 - Authority Letter.
 - CNIC of the authorized person.
 - An affidavit confirming that the company is not blacklisted anywhere.
 - Relevant Work Orders / Completion Certificates.
 - Business Profile for last 3years.
 - Bid Security.
 - Bank Statement / Financial Capacity Documents
3. The competent authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids in accordance with the provisions envisaged under Rule-33 of PPRA Rules 2004.
4. No bidder will be allowed to alter or modify his/ her bid after opening of the bids.
5. No conditional bids will be accepted.
6. Samples / details in respect of all items should be attached with the tender / Bid, otherwise the same will not be considered.
7. Rates should be inclusive of all taxes.
8. Bids must be attached with a pay order in the name of Deputy Collector (Hqrs), Collectorate of Customs Enforcement, Multan equivalent to Pak Rs.100,000/- as a call deposit.
9. No escalation in rates / price shall be admissible.
10. A separate agreement shall be executed with successful bidder.
11. The successful Bidder shall furnish Performance Security amounting to Rs. 200,000/- within three days of issuance of Letter of Acceptance.
12. The Contractor shall be responsible for timely delivery, uninterrupted supply, safe transportation and proper packaging and hygienic food.

13. The contractor shall maintain operational confidentiality regarding anti-smuggling operations, deployments, movement plan and official activities.
14. Rates shall include transportation, labor, loading / unloading, taxes, packing and all incidental charges.
15. All provincial local and federal taxes will be applicable.
16. Rejected / substandard items shall be replaced immediately at contractor's own risk and cost.
17. Agreement shall remain valid till 30th June, 2026, unless terminated earlier.
18. Supply shall be made through Supply Orders issued to as-and-when required basis.
19. Inspection Committee may inspect transport, storage, contractor's premises and hygiene standards at any time.
20. Payment shall be made subject to satisfactory performance, inspection certification, invoice verification and budget availability, delivery challans and operational feedback.
21. The contractor shall not sublet the contract in any case.
22. The contractor shall ensure uninterrupted supply on weekends and public holidays.
23. All delivery expenses shall be borne by contractor.
24. No advance shall be admissible.
25. Taxes shall be deducted at source as per law.
26. Bills shall be supported with delivery challans and supply verification.
27. The Procuring Agency may terminate the contract wholly or partially in case of repeated complaints or unsatisfactory performance.
28. Incomplete quotations will not be considered in any case.
