NOTIFICATION
(CUSTOMS)

S.R.O (I)/2004- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 and 4 of THE Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), and sections 30 and 31 of the Sales Tax Act, 1990, the Central Board of Revenue is pleased to direct that the following amendments shall be made in its Notification No. S.R.O.41(I)/2000 dated the 1st February, 2000, namely:-

In the aforesaid Notification, in the Schedule,

- (a) in column 1, for serial No. 1,2 and 3 and entries relating thereto in columns 2 and 3 the following shall be substituted, namely:-

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| 1. Collector of Customs, (Appraisement), Custom House, Karachi. | All matters including imports, transshipment, transit and warehousing relating of Custom House, Karachi, the Port of Karachi and Al-Hamd International Containers Terminal but excluding the work assigned to Model Customs Collectorate, Karachi, Collectorate of Customs (Preventive), Collectorate of Customs (Exports), Port Muhammad Bin Qasim, Karachi. |
| 2. Collector of Customs (Preventive), Custom House, Karachi | <p>All matters relating to the following in the Civil Division of Karachi, the Port of Karachi including Fish Harbour and AICT, Postal Appraisement at GPO, Karachi, Ibrahim Hydery, the Pakistan Customs Waters, Quaid-e-Azam International Airport, Karachi, Faisal Airbase and Masroor Airbase, Karachi, Lasbeila District and Thatta but excluding the Karachi International Containers Terminal, namely:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) Preventive Divisions at East and West Wharves;(ii) Unaccompanied ' Baggage Sections at East and West wharves and N.M.B Wharf;(iii) Passenger traffic at East and West wharves;(iv) Anti-smuggling Organization;(v) Drug Enforcement Cell;(vi) Postal Appraisement Department;(vii) Duty Free Shops;(viii) Work at the Quaid-e-Azam International Airport Karachi, relating to imports, warehousesoperated or owned by |

Airlines, accompanied or unaccompanied baggage, International Passenger traffic and related preventive work;

- (ix) Bulk oil imports; and
- (x) Diplomatic bonded warehouses.

- 3 Collector of Customs, (Export), Custom House, Karachi.
- All matters relating to the following in the Civil Division of Karachi, Port of Karachi, Port Muhammad Bin Qasim and Quaid-e-Azam International Airport, Karachi but excluding Karachi International Containers Terminal, namely:-
- (i) E.G.M Section, Custom House;
 - (ii) Export Rebate Section;
 - (iii) Manufacturing Warehouses(Open Bonds Scheme);
 - (iv) Manufacturing Bond Group;
 - (v) Industrial Survey Section;
 - (vi) Export Processing Section, West Wharf excluding Karachi International Containers Terminal;
 - (vii) Export Processing Section, East Wharf;
 - (viii) Export Processing Group, M.I. Yard;
 - (ix) Export Processing Zone, Landhi;
 - (x) Export Processing Group at the Quaid-e-Azam International Karachi;
 - (xi) Duty and Tax Remission for Export (DTRE) scheme;
 - (xii) Temporary importation; and
 - (xiii) All other matters relating to export work.”; and

- (b) in column I, after Serial No.3 substituted as aforesaid, the following new serial No. and entries relating thereto in column 2 and 3 shall be inserted, namely:-

- “3A. Model Collectorate of Customs, Karachi.
- (i) All customs work relating to import and export of cargo, beaggage, transit, transshipment, warehousing, ship clearance, boarding and rummaging and monitoring of gatesincluding anti-smuggling and drug enforcement functions through the Krachi International Containers Terminal;
 - (ii) Maintenance of centralized data regarding the particulars of survey certificates for whole of Karachi in the form and manner and to the extent as may be prescribed form time to time;
 - (iii) Maintenance of centralized data regarding particulars of licenses of agents for the whole of Karachi in the form and manner and to the extent as may be prescribed form time to time; and
 - (iv) Maintenance of centralized data regarding particulars of licences granted to warehouses for whole of Karachi and for private warehouses for whole of Pakistan in the

form and manner and to the extent as may be prescribed from time to time.
