**NOTIFICATION
(SALES TAX)**

S.R.O.922(I)/99.- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to sub-section (1) of section 13 of the Sales Tax Act, 1990, the Federal Government is pleased to direct that the exemptions from sales tax granted under the Sixth Schedule to the said Act on the goods as specified in column (2) of the Table below shall be withdrawn from the date specified in column (3) of the Table:-
